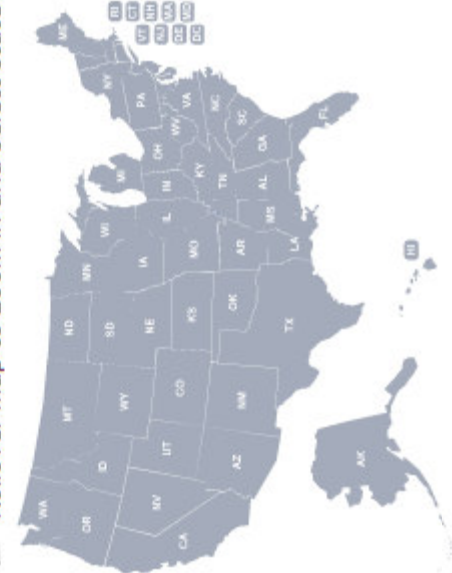

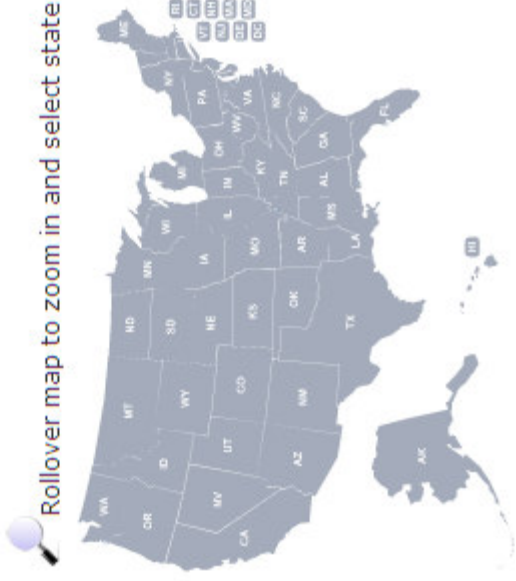

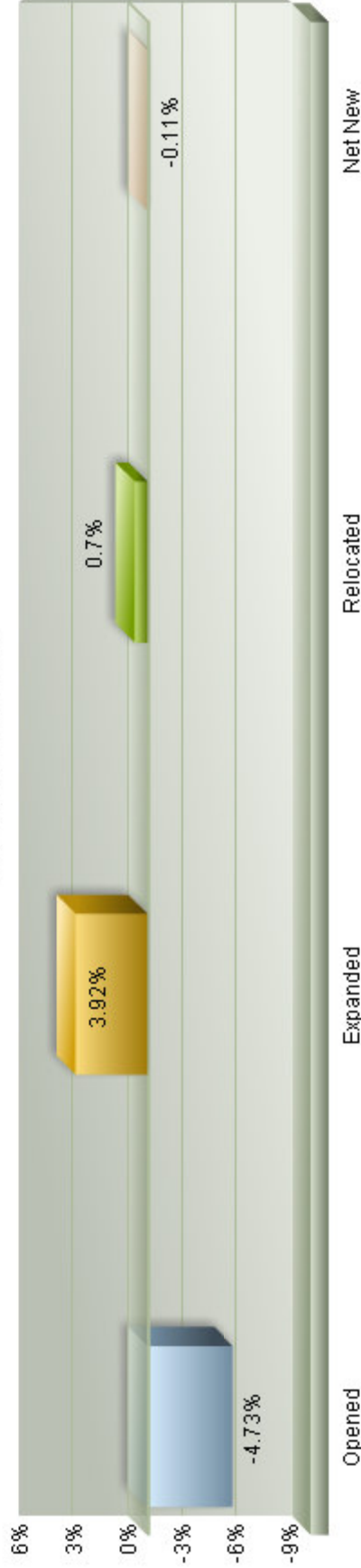
Between 2000 and 2007 in Connecticut, the number of jobs **fell by 0.11%** from 2000. Primarily, this job loss was caused by establishments that went out of business during this period causing a **4.73%** reduction of jobs. The number of job losses would have been greater if the expansions of existing companies had not added **3.92%** more jobs during the same period. About **0.7%** of job gains came from companies moving into Connecticut.
